A REGULAR MEETING of the BOARD OF ALDERMEN of the TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS, was held on, March 12, 2024, at 6:00 P.M., in the TOWN MUNICIPAL OFFICE, 3301 CARMEN AVENUE, RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS to consider the following items:

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Guerrero at 6:00 PM.

2. ROLL CALL:

Roll call was made by Isabel Perales, Assistant Town Secretary.

Members present at the meeting were: Mark Johnson, Marcos Ricoy, and Javier Vera

Members absent: Laura Kaechele and Alfredo Hernandez

A quorum was present at the meeting.

Legal counsel David Irwin, Town Administrator Fred Blanco, and Police Chief Robert Tyler were also present at the meeting.

3. INVOCATION AND PLEDGE:

Mayor Guerrero led the group in the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the American and Texas flags.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Motion was made by Alderman Vera, seconded by Alderman Johnson, and unanimously carried, to open public comment.

Belinda Mendez from Las Jacarandas Condos said that she had Ulrich Weisse on the phone, and he would like to speak during public comment. Mr. Weisse stated that he spoke to Town Administrator Fred Blanco about the outcome of the special meeting regarding cul-de-sacs. He asked about the Town paving public or private cul-de-sacs and asked what was being considered. Mr. Weisse stated that he wanted to go on record so that it may reflect in the minutes.

Motion was then made by Alderman Vera, seconded by Alderman Johnson, and unanimously carried, to close the public comment.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – FEBRUARY 13, 2024:

Motion was made by Alderman Vera, seconded by Alderman Johnson, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held on February 13, 2024, as written.

7. CONSIDERATION/ACTION ON FARMERS MARKET AGREEMENT RENEWAL:

Mr. Blanco stated there were no changes to the current agreement, everything was to remain the same. Mayor Guerrero recommended the renewal of the agreement for the Special Event Permit for Farmer's Market. Bonnie Emerson, Director of Farmer's Market stated that they will be hosting an Easter Egg Hunt at the next market. Mayor Guerrero said that for Easter and in partnership with the Town, the Town would provide 2 officers at no extra charges.

Motion was made by Alderman Vera and seconded by Alderman Ricoy, to approve the renewal agreement for Farmer's Market for one year; the motion passed with the following vote: AYES: Alderman Ricoy and Alderman Vera NAYES: None ABSTAINING: Alderman Johnson

8. CONSIDERATION/ACTION ON MUNICIPAL JUDGE CONTRACT RENEWAL:

Alderman Vera asked about the starting day for the contract renewal. Motion was made by Alderman Vera, seconded by Alderman Ricoy, and unanimously carried, to approve the Municipal Judge contract renewal with Javier Gonzalez for a two-year term starting 3/12/2024 and good through 3/12/2026.

6. DELINQUENT TAX COLLECTION REPORT FOR THE PERIOD ENDING SEPTEMBER 2023 - LINEBARGER GOGGAN BLAIR & SAMPSON, LLP:

Ariana Curiel Magallanes from Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP presented the Delinquent Tax Collection Report for the Town of Rancho Viejo for the period ending in September 2023. Mrs. Curiel Magallanes gave details on the collection process, pre-litigation, and litigation activities, and presented an analysis of collection performance from 2018 to 2022.

10. AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) MULTI-USE FACILITY PROJECT UPDATE:

Mayor Guerrero updated that they were currently working on the x-ray of the slab for the tennis courts.

11. COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE:

Mayor Guerrero informed that they had met Edgar Sada from GrantWorks and that they made changes to and finalized the survey for residents' input on the comprehensive plan. Mayor Guerrero also stated that the Town will be sending an alert and handing out hard copies to residents at Farmer's Market. Town Administrator Fred Blanco mentioned the survey would be finalized today and it would be featured for 30 days.

A RESOLUTION ORDERING THE ELECTION FOR RANCHO VIEJO, DESIGNATION OF ELECTION PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES, DESIGNATION OF METHOD OF VOTING, SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION BY CANDIDATES, APPOINTMENT OF EARLY VOTING CLERK, AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION NOTICE

WHEREAS, an election is hereby ordered for the purpose of voting for three (3) Aldermen for a two year term for the Town of Rancho Viejo.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS:

- SECTION 1. That the Order of Election for the Town of Rancho Viejo, Texas, signed by Mayor Maribel B. Guerrero and members of the Board of Aldermen dated January 16, 2024, for the election to be held on May 4, 2024, is hereby ratified and adopted in all respects.
- SECTION 2. Said election is to be held on Saturday, May 4, 2024, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. for qualified electors residing within the incorporated area of the Town of Rancho Viejo, and notice is further given that the polling place for such election is hereby designated as the Town Municipal Office, 3301 Carmen Avenue, Rancho Viejo, Texas. - SECTION 3. Application by candidates for the offices for which the herein described election is called, shall address application for a place on the ballot to the Town Administrator of the Town of Rancho Viejo, Texas and said application shall be accompanied by the statutory oath of candidate for election as provided by the Texas Election Code, and said application shall be filed with the Town Administrator at the Town Municipal Office, 3301 Carmen Avenue, Rancho Viejo, Texas. The first day for filing said application is Wednesday, January 17, 2024, and the last day for filing said application is Friday, February 16, 2024, at 5:00 P.M.
- SECTION 4. The Town Administrator or his deputy is hereby appointed Clerk for Early Voting, which Early Voting shall be held at the Town Municipal Office located at 3301 Carmen Avenue in Rancho Viejo, Texas. The period to vote early in person at the Town Administrator's Office is Monday, April 22, 2024, through Friday, April 26, 2024, (9:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.) Saturday, April 27, (10:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.) Monday, April 29 through Tuesday, April 30, 2024 (9:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.).

Application to vote by mail shall be addressed to the Town Administrator, Town of Rancho Viejo, 3301 Carmen Avenue, Rancho Viejo, Texas 78575. Applications for ballot by mail or electronic submission of a scanned application must be received no later than the close of business on Tuesday, April 23, 2024. Electronic submission of a scanned application with an original signature shall be e-mailed to townhall@ranchoviejotexas.com.

- SECTION 5. Any person who wishes to be a write-in candidate must make a declaration of write-in candidacy pursuant to Chapter 146 of the Texas Election Code and in compliance with said law, no write-in vote will be counted unless the name written in appears on the list of write-in candidates as required by Chapter 146 of the Texas Election Code.
- SECTION 6. Notice of the election order by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Rancho Viejo, Texas shall be given by publication in the SAN BENITO NEWS one time.

Interlocal Cooperation Contract Failure to Appear Program

State of Texas County of _____

I. PARTIES AND AUTHORITY

This Interlocal Cooperation Contract (Contract) is entered into between the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas (DPS), an agency of the State of Texas and the ______ Court of the [City or County] of ______ (Court), a political subdivision of the State of Texas, referred to collectively in this Contract as the Parties, under the authority granted in Tex. Transp. Code Chapter 706 and Tex. Gov't Code Chapter 791 (the Interlocal Cooperation Act).

II. BACKGROUND

A peace officer authorized to issue citations within the jurisdiction of the Court must issue a written warning to each person to whom the officer issues a citation for a traffic law violation. This warning must be provided in addition to any other warnings required by law. The warning must state in substance that if the person fails to appear in court for the prosecution of the offense or if the person fails to pay or satisfy a judgment ordering the payment of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the Court, the person may be denied renewal of the person's driver license.

As permitted under Tex. Transp. Code § 706.008, DPS contracts with a private vendor (Vendor) to provide and establish an automated Failure to Appear (FTA) system that accurately stores information regarding violators subject to the provisions of Tex. Transp. Code Chapter 706. DPS uses the FTA system to properly deny renewal of a driver license to a person who is the subject of an FTA system entry generated from an FTA Report.

An FTA Report is a notice sent by Court requesting a person be denied renewal of a driver's license in accordance with this Contract. The Court may submit an FTA Report to DPS's Vendor if a person fails to appear or fails to pay or satisfy a judgment as required by law. There is no requirement that a criminal warrant be issued in response to the person's failure to appear.

III. PURPOSE

This Contract applies to each FTA Report submitted by the Court to DPS or its Vendor and accepted by DPS or its Vendor.

IV. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

This Contract will be effective on the date of execution and terminate five years from that execution date unless terminated earlier in accordance with Section VII.C, *General Terms and Conditions, Termination*.

V. COURT RESPONSIBILITIES

A. FTA Report

For a matter involving any offense which a Court has jurisdiction of under Tex. Code Crim. Proc. Chapter 4, where a person fails to appear for a complaint or citation or fails to pay or satisfy a judgment ordering payment of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the Court, the Court will supply DPS, through its Vendor, an FTA report including the information that is necessary to deny renewal of the driver license of that person. The Court must make reasonable efforts to ensure that all FTA Reports are accurate, complete, and non-duplicative. The FTA Report must include the following information:

- 1. the jurisdiction in which the alleged offense occurred;
- 2. the name of the court submitting the report;
- 3. the name, date of birth, and Texas driver license number of the person who failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a judgment;
- 4. the date of the alleged violation;
- 5. a brief description of the alleged violation;
- 6. a statement that the person failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a judgment as required by law;
- 7. the date that the person failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a judgment; and
- 8. any other information required by DPS.

B. Clearance Reports

The Court that files the FTA Report has a continuing obligation to review the FTA Report and promptly submit appropriate additional information or reports to the Vendor. The clearance report must identify the person, state whether or not a fee was required, and advise DPS to lift the denial of renewal and state the grounds for the action. All clearance reports must be submitted immediately, but no later than two business days from the time and date that the Court receives appropriate payment or other information that satisfies the person's obligation to that Court.

To the extent that a Court uses the FTA system by submitting an FTA Report, the Court must collect the statutorily required \$10.00 reimbursement fee from the person who failed to appear, pay or satisfy a judgment ordering payment of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the Court. If the person is acquitted of the underlying offense for which the original FTA Report was filed or found indigent by the court, the Court will not require payment of the reimbursement fee.

Court must submit a clearance report for the following circumstances:

- 1. the perfection of an appeal of the case for which the warrant of arrest was issued or judgment arose;
- 2. the dismissal of the charge for which the warrant of arrest was issued or judgment arose;
- 3. the posting of a bond or the giving of other security to reinstate the charge for which the warrant was issued;
- 4. the payment or discharge of the fine and cost owed on an outstanding judgment of the Court; or
- 5. other suitable arrangement to satisfy the fine and cost within the Court's discretion.

After termination of the Contract, the Court has a continuing obligation to report dispositions and collect fees for all violators in the FTA system at the time of termination. Failure to comply with the continuing obligation to report will result in the removal of all outstanding entries of the Court in the FTA Report, resulting in the lifting of any denied driver license renewal status from DPS.

C. Quarterly Reports and Audits

Court must submit quarterly reports to DPS in a format established by DPS.

Court is subject to audit and inspection at any time during normal business hours and at a mutually agreed upon location by the state auditor, DPS, and any other department or agency, responsible for determining that the Parties have complied with the applicable laws. Court must provide all reasonable facilities and assistance for the safe and convenient performance of any audit or inspection.

Court must correct any non-conforming transactions performed by the Court, at its own cost, until acceptable to DPS.

Court must keep all records and documents regarding this Contract for the term of this Contract and for seven years after the termination of this Contract, or until DPS or the State Auditor's Office (SAO) is satisfied that all audit and litigation matters are resolved, whichever period is longer.

D. Accounting Procedures

Court must keep separate, accurate, and complete records of the funds collected and disbursed and must deposit the funds in the appropriate municipal or county treasury. Court may deposit such fees in an interest-bearing account and retain the interest earned on such accounts for the Court.

Court will allocate \$6.00 of each \$10.00 reimbursement fee received for payment to the Vendor and \$4.00 for credit to the general fund of the municipal or county treasury.

E. Non-Waiver of Fees

Court will not waive the \$10.00 reimbursement fee for any person that has been submitted on an FTA Report, unless any of the requirements in Tex. Trans. Code § 706.006(a) or §706.006(d) are met.

Failure to comply with this section will result in: (i) termination of this Contract for cause; and (ii) the removal of all outstanding entries of the Court in the FTA Report, resulting in the lifting of any denied driver license renewal status from DPS.

F. Litigation Notice

The Court must make a good-faith attempt to immediately notify DPS in the event that the Court becomes aware of litigation in which this Contract or Tex. Transp. Code Chapter 706 is subject to constitutional, statutory, or common-law challenge, or is struck down by judicial decision.

VI. DPS's RESPONSIBILITIES

DPS will not continue to deny renewal of the person's driver license after receiving notice from the Court that the FTA Report was submitted in error or has been destroyed in accordance with the Court's record retention policy.

VII. PAYMENTS TO VENDOR

Court must pay the Vendor a fee of \$6.00 per person for each violation that has been reported to the Vendor and for which the Court has subsequently collected the statutorily required \$10.00 reimbursement fee. In the event that the fee has been waived by Tex. Trans. Code § 706.006(a) or §706.006(d), no payment will be made to the Vendor.

Court agrees that payment will be made to the Vendor no later than the last day of the month following the close of the calendar quarter in which the payment was received by the Court.

DPS will not pay Vendor for any fees that should have been submitted by a Court.

VIII. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A. Compliance with Law. This Contract is governed by and construed under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. The Court understands and agrees that it will comply with all local, state, and federal laws in the performance of this Contract, including administrative rules adopted by DPS.
- **B.** Notice. The respective party will send the other party notice as noted in this section. Either party may change its information by giving the other party written notice and the effective date of the change.

C. Termination.

Either party may terminate this Contract with 30 days' written notice.

DPS may also terminate this Contract for cause if Court doesn't comply with Section V.C., *Quarterly Reports and Audits* and V.E., *Non- Waiver of Fees*.

If either Party is subject to a lack of appropriations that are necessary for that Party's performance of its obligations under this Contract, the Contract is subject to immediate cancellation or termination, without penalty to either Party.

D. Amendments.

This contract may only be amended by mutual written agreement of the Parties.

E. Miscellaneous.

1. The parties shall use the dispute resolution process provided for in Chapter 2260 of the Texas Government Code to resolve any disputes under this Contract; provided

however nothing in this paragraph shall preclude either Party from pursuing any remedies available under Texas law.

- 2. This Contract shall not constitute or be construed as a waiver of any of the privileges, rights, defenses, remedies, or immunities available to either Party or the State of Texas.
- 3. Any alterations, additions, or deletions to the terms of the contract that are required by changes in federal or state law or regulations are automatically incorporated into the contract without written amendment hereto, and shall become effective on the date designated by such law or by regulation.

CERTIFICATIONS

The Parties certify that (1) the Contract is authorized by the governing body of each party; (2) the purpose, terms, rights, and duties of the Parties are stated within the Contract; and (3) each party will make payments for the performance of governmental functions or services from current revenues available to the paying party.


