ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS, AMENDING ARTICLE IV OF CHAPTER 62 "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES"; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND PUBLICATION IN CAPTION FORM

WHEREAS, for the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Town of Rancho Viejo, Texas, parking regulations are deemed to be in the best interest of the residents of the Town of Rancho Viejo, Texas;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority granted by the Section 542.202(a)(2) of the Texas Transportation Code, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. That the Board of Aldermen finds and determines the foregoing recitals to be true and correct and hereby makes them part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That Article IV of Chapter 62 "Traffic and Motor Vehicles" is hereby amended by creating Section 62-81 "No Parking Zones".

SECTION 3. That newly created Section 62-81 shall read as follows:

"It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle, or to allow any vehicle to stop or stand at any time in the following places:

- (1) On any private land that is visible from any other private land or public area, except as to an area paved and prepared as a driveway.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. That the Code of the Town of Rancho Viejo, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, save and except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 5. That if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid for any purpose, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 6. That it is hereby found and determined that the meetings at which this ordinance was passed were open to the public, as required by Section 551.001 et. seq., Texas Government Code, and that advance public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meetings was given.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage and publication, and it is accordingly so ordained.
