Alderwoman Carr led the group in the invocation and pledge of allegiance to the American and Texas flags.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mayor Rathbun congratulated Attorney David Irwin for the birth of his first son. Volunteer Fire Department Chief, Russ St. Peter said they have acquired new equipment to be able to do search and rescue in a home in case of a fire, they have also received new valves to be able to connect the hoses to the fire hydrants much faster. The Volunteer Fire Department will be doing practice burns to train with the new equipment. There was no further comment.

Alderwoman Carr recommended Mrs. Garcia as a member to the Beautification Committee. REPORT FROM STREET COMMITTEE:

Alderwoman Guerrero gave an update on the Street Committee. The Street Committee has been meeting every Monday and the meetings are very thorough and they are working on determining prioritization and funding. They are looking into several different sources. There is a meeting scheduled with TXDOT.

REPORT FROM BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE:

Alderwoman Carr gave an update on the Beautification Committee, the total number of members is 7, committee meets every 3rd Thursday of the month at 4:00 P.M., they have accomplished many goals and are planning on having the next block party on Santa Ana and then continue on Carmen. They are also going to continue working with VMUD and the Club in unison for a more beautiful and community oriented and engaged Town.

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES IN THE MAY 7, 2016 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION ELECTED TO OFFICE; CANCELING THE ELECTION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the general municipal election was called for May 7, 2016 for the purpose of electing members to the Board of Aldermen; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified in writing that there is no proposition on the ballot, that no person has made a declaration of write-in candidacy, and that each candidate on the ballot is unopposed for election to office; and

WHEREAS, under these circumstances, Subchapter C, Chapter 2, Election Code, authorizes the Board of Aldermen to declare the candidates elected to office and cancel the election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO:

Section 1. The following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 7, 2016 general municipal election, are declared elected to office, and shall be issued certificates of election following the time the election would have been canvassed:

Section 2. The May 7, 2016 general municipal election is canceled, and the City Secretary is directed to cause a copy of the Order of Cancellation to be posted on Election Day at each polling place that would have been used in the election.

Section 3. It is declared to be the intent of the Board of Aldermen that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance is declared invalid by the judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance since the Board of Aldermen would have enacted them without the invalid portion.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and it is so ordained.
