10. CONSIDERATION/ADOPTION OF BUDGET ORDINANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2019 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2020

Motion was made by Alderman Vera, seconded by Alderwoman Guerrero, and unanimously carried to approve Ordinance No. 235- AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALMDERMEN APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS, AS PREPARED BY THE MAYOR FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020. The adoption of said budget is contingent upon a correction to add 2019 property tax line item.

11. CONSIDERATION/RATIFICATION OF THE PROPERTY TAX (REVENUE) INCREASE REFLECTED IN THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2019 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2020

Motion was made by Alderman Vera, seconded by Alderwoman Guerrero and unanimously carried to ratify that this budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$ 35,989 or 2.999034% \$18,289 tax revenue from new property added to the roll next year.

12. CONSIDERATION/ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AD VALOREM TAX RATE TO PROVIDE FOR BUDGET EXPENSES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 – 2020

Motion was made by Alderman Tumlinson, seconded by Alderwoman Guerrero and unanimously carried, that the property tax rate by increased by the adoption of a tax rate of .450000, which is effectively a 2.062730 percent increase in the tax rate; and to pass, adopt and approve Ordinance No. 236 – AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AD VALOREM AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR THE TAX YEAR 2019, SETTING THE ASSESSED VALUATION AT ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%) OF THE FAIR MARKET VALUE, PROVIDING FOR A HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION OF \$5,000, PROVIDING FOR DISCOUNTS IN THE EVENT OF EARLY PAYMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY AND INTEREST IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW AND PROIDING FOR SEVERABILITY. The total tax rate adopted was \$0.450000.



#### **PEST ALERT**

Xanthomonas axonopodis pv. citri (Xac)
Citrus Canker



Citrus Canker symptoms on Persian Lime Fruit Photo: USDA-PPQ, Los Indios, TX

Xanthomonas axonopodis is the causal agent of Citrus Canker, a serious disease to commercial citrus varieties.

The pathogen causes necrotic lesions on leaves, stems and fruit. Severe infections can cause defoliation, badly blemished fruit, premature fruit drop, twig dieback and general tree decline. As to 2007 a total of 16,523,176 trees had been destroyed due to this disease.

What does citrus canker look like? Symptoms on leaves and fruit are brown, raised lesions surrounded by an oily, water-soaked margin and a yellow ring or halo. Old lesions in leaves may fall out, creating a shot-hole effect.

Is the disease harmful to humans and animals? No, citrus canker does not harm humans or animals or plant life other than citrus.

Does canker affect only orange trees?


Citrus canker affects all types of citrus, including oranges, sour oranges, grapefruit, tangerines, lemons and limes. Canker causes the citrus tree to continually decline in health and fruit production. Ultimately, the tree will produce no fruit at all.

The bacterial pathogen enters plant tissues through natural openings (stomates) and wounds.

The pathogen is not systemic in the host plant. *Xac* can remain viable as long as host cells in the vicinity of the lesion remain viable, though the bacterial titer will drop considerably.


Citrus canker is highly contagious and can be spread rapidly by:


- Windborne rain
- Lawnmowers and other landscaping equipment
- People carrying the infection on their hands, clothing, or equipment
- Moving infected or exposed plants or plant parts




Cirtus Canker lesion on Citrus leaves. Photo: USDA, Dan Robl




#### Pathology

- Spread by the bacteria Xanthomonas citri.
- ▶ This is a gram negative, aerobic and rod shaped bacteria.
- Opportunistic bacteria will enter the plant through the plants stomata or wounds in the leaves.
- lt is an airborne pathogen that is carried by rain, wind and cross contamination.
- Leads to shoot die back and fruit drop.
- Cosmetic damage to the fruit that will damage its table top value.

#### The Mission

- ▶ Create public awareness of the citrus industry and the economic impact it has in the Rio Grande Valley.
- ▶ Federal and state governments spent over 1.4 billion dollars in the eradication efforts in Florida and failed.
- Strategize on how to use current resources to educate the public of the citrus disease and its symptoms.
- Establish a relationship with local and state agencies.
- ▶ Create a strategic approach on preventing the spread Citrus Canker.
- Regulatory practices and approaches in containing the pathogen.
- Ultimately eradicate the disease from our community.



#### The Approach

- ▶ Since the quarantine was first established in Rancho Viejo in the fall of 2015 the USDA has taken an Emergency Response.
- ► TDA (Texas Department of Agriculture) will lead in the removal of any infected plant material. This will include the destruction of the infected trees.
- ▶ The biggest threats to a successful eradication are cross contamination.
- The approach is to issue a compliance agreements between the USDA and the landscaping entities, waste managements, nursery owners and any business that is contact with the live plant tissue.
- ▶ We have a citrus hotline available to aid with any questions about the program. 956-205-7702 M-F 8-4pm.

#### Method

- ► The quarantine is created by half a mile radius from the latest confirm positive.
- ▶ Split the area by grids and assigned to teams for sampling and tagging of possible positive findings.
- ▶ Surveying door to door and take plant samples for confirmation of disease.
- ▶ Educate the consumer of disease and ways we can stop the spread the disease.
- ▶ Reach out to public officials to provide support and generate new approaches on containment.

**Reference:** Contract Renewal/Extension – Answers to requests for additional information as per the Board of Alderman Meeting on September 10, 2019

Dear Mr. Blanco,

As part of our ongoing discussion for extension of contract and the offer presented to the Town of Rancho Viejo, I wanted to provide you with answers to several questions and requests made from various Aldermen/Alderwomen. Below you will find Republic Services' response to their questions and/or requests as part of the negotiations.

- Question If the Town of Rancho Viejo chooses to go with CPI based on 100% WST, can the CAP of annual rate be set at 4%? <u>Answer:</u> Yes. Therefore, the highest possible rate increase from one year to another cannot be higher than 4% or explained in a different manner, may range from 0% 4%.
- Question Can monthly billing be an option? Answer: Yes. We can build in our system a choice for monthly billing if that is an absolute requirement or request that we provide. Keep in mind that there would be a billing fee of a \$1.50 assessed to accounts that decide to go on a monthly billing cycle. This fee is due to the increase in billings to the customer of 12 times per year rather than 4 times (quarterly billed) or one time (annually billed).
- Question Can Republic Services provide 1 or 2 times per year, 1- roll-off container for special clean up projects as been provided in the past? Answer: Yes Republic Services will provide the Town of Rancho Viejo with 1 Roll-off container 2 times per year for special clean up projects so long as the items being cleaned up and placed in roll-off container are acceptable wastes that we currently service as part of our industrial Roll-off services. Any hazardous waste materials, tires or waste that would need to be manifested will not be allowed.
- Question Referencing the total number of accounts that are setup for services and discussion of additional Franchise Fee revenue opportunities to be determined by way of a percentage of price (i.e., 1%, 2%, 3%, etc...of price). Answer: There is currently a total of 877 accounts signed up for services with Republic Services. Of these 877 accounts, 55 of them have 2 carts in place. The annual billing revenues for these accounts is approximately

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\$314,000. Therefore, if the Town of Rancho Viejo decides to add a flat percentage Franchise Fee, this should give you an indication of what the Town can expect in earnings.

I hope this will help answer all questions and concerns that were brought to the forefront of our conversation for the extension of the contract and hope you find the information useful in helping the Town of Rancho Viejo to make their decision. Once again, we hope that you will consider this extension/renewal offer and look forward to continuing our relationship with the Town of Rancho Viejo.
