APRIL 1, 2020: OFFICIAL CENSUS DAY IN CAMERON COUNTY

Beginning Mid-March, the U.S. Census Bureau began inviting all households around the Country to participate in the 2020 Census and make sure that every single person living in the United States is counted. This count is very important and crucial as it will determine the number of seats each state will hold in the U.S. House of Representatives, as well as influencing decisions about how hundreds of billions of dollars are allocated each year for the next ten years to local communities for vital services such as educational programs, healthcare, highways, roads, bridges, first responders and law enforcement.

“An accurate Census is critical for our growth and future and now it’s our time to let ourselves be counted and help shape the future of our local communities” stated Cameron County Judge Eddie Treviño, Jr. “This Census Count comes to us in a critical moment in life and I cannot stress enough the importance of what this count will mean to our communities. We must all do our part to respond and let ourselves be counted. Responding to the U.S. Census is easy, safe and important and may be done in one of three ways: online, by phone, or by mail.”

As of today, the Country’s response rate is 38.4%, Texas is 33.4%, and Cameron County is 21.6%. Please participate in the 2020 Census and remember that the 2020 Count will help shape our future.
