**SUPPLEMENTAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORDER AND  
RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING ADDITIONAL TRAVEL  
RESTRICTIONS AND FACE COVERINGS**

**THIS ORDER AND RECOMMENDATIONS IS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE FIRST AMENDED EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORDER WITH MANDATORY COUNTYWIDE SHELTER IN PLACE.**

**FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDER CONSTITUTES AN IMMINENT THREAT TO PUBLIC HEALTH.**

This Order shall become effective at 12:01a.m. on Wednesday, April 8, 2020, and will continue to be in effect until 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, April 21, 2020, or until it is rescinded in writing by the Cameron County Judge.

Passenger vehicle travel shall be limited to no more than two (2) individuals per vehicle. It is recommended that passenger vehicle travel be voluntarily limited to only one (1) person per vehicle. This order and recommendation is based upon the CDC social distancing guideline of six (6) feet of separation between individuals. It is not possible in most passenger vehicles to maintain that distance. In recognition of the occasional necessity to have more than one person in a vehicle it is recommended that if more than one (1) person is in a vehicle each person wear a face covering or mask. In addition all individuals in the County should wear face coverings or masks when in public. It is further ordered that no children under fourteen (14) years of age accompany parents or guardians for routine grocery, supplies or gasoline replenishment trips. Trips for medical attention, health care or mandatory educational materials and school food program distribution for children under the age of fourteen (14) are exempt from this order.
