Cameron County Confirms Additional COVID-19 Related Deaths

Cameron County has received confirmation of five additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County Residents. The individuals were a 63-year female of Primera and passed away at Harlingen Medical Center. In addition, there was a 32-year old male from Harlingen, a 69-year old male from Harlingen, a 56-year old male of Los Indios, and a 82-year old male from Harlingen. This raises the number of COVID-19 related deaths in Cameron County to 96.

Cameron County has also received confirmation of an additional 326 laboratory reports of COVID-19. This includes the following:

This raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 5,891 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional seventy-one (71) individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 2,831.

Cameron County Public Health continues to work with the six nursing home facilities and one detention center in addressing the COVID-19 outbreaks. To date, the Cameron County cases arising from the Port Isabel Service Processing Center has 12 employees and 78 detainees who have tested positive.
