Cameron County Confirms Fourth COVID-19 Related Death

Cameron County has received confirmation of its fourth COVID-19 related death of a Cameron County resident. The resident was an 82-year old female from the Veranda Nursing Home in Harlingen and passed away at the facility. The individual had been previously reported as a case for Cameron County.

Cameron County has also received confirmation of an additional sixteen (16) reports of COVID-19. This includes the following:

This raises the total number of cases to 270 in Cameron County. Of the 270 cases, 96 individuals have recovered.

Cameron County Public Health continues to investigate the COVID-19 outbreak at the two nursing home facilities. To date, the Cameron County cases arising from the Veranda Nursing Home has included 21 employees, five (5) individuals related to the employees and 50 residents who have tested positive, including three (3) who have passed away. There have also been 37 employees and 24 residents who have tested negative. The Windsor Atrium currently has 20 employees and 17 residents who have tested positive, including one who has passed away. There has also been five (5) employees and two (3) residents who have tested negative.
