## Cameron County Confirms Additional COVID-19 Cases

Cameron County has received confirmation of an additional nine (9) reports of COVID-19. This includes the following:

This raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 421 in Cameron County. Of the 421 cases, 191 individuals have recovered.

Cameron County Public Health continues to work with the two nursing home facilities in addressing the COVID-19 outbreaks. To date, the Cameron County cases arising from the Veranda Nursing Home has included 31 employees and 58 residents who have tested positive, including ten (10) who have passed away. The Windsor Atrium currently has 31 employees and 33 residents who have tested positive. They have had seven (7) individuals linked to Windsor Atrium who have passed away.

As part of the COVID-19 action response plan, Cameron County Public Health is conducting epidemiological investigations, contact tracing as needed, and continues to monitor the situation.
