Cameron County Confirms Additional COVID-19 Cases

Cameron County has received confirmation of eighteen (18) additional reports of COVID-19. This includes the following:

This raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 512 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional nine (9) individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 265.

Cameron County Public Health continues to work with the two nursing home facilities in addressing the COVID-19 outbreaks. To date, the Cameron County cases arising from the Veranda Nursing Home has included 32 employees and 60 residents who have tested positive, including ten (10) who have passed away. The Windsor Atrium currently has 32 employees and 54 residents who have tested positive. They have had nine (9) individuals linked to Windsor Atrium who have passed away.

As part of the COVID-19 action response plan, Cameron County Public Health is conducting epidemiological investigations, contact tracing as needed, and continues to monitor the situation.
