### Cameron County Confirms Additional COVID-19 Related Deaths

Cameron County has received confirmation of two additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. The individuals were a 63-year old male from Harlingen and 63-year old male from La Feria. This raises the number of COVID-19 related deaths in Cameron County to 79.

Cameron County has also received confirmation of an additional 358 laboratory reports of COVID-19. This includes the following:

This raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 3,854 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional one hundred and forty-four (144) individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 2,548.

Cameron County Public Health continues to work with the six nursing home facilities and one detention center in addressing the COVID-19 outbreaks. To date, the Cameron County cases arising from the Port Isabel Service Processing Center has 11 employees and 75 detainees who have tested positive.
